## Alabama Book Festival April 19, 2008

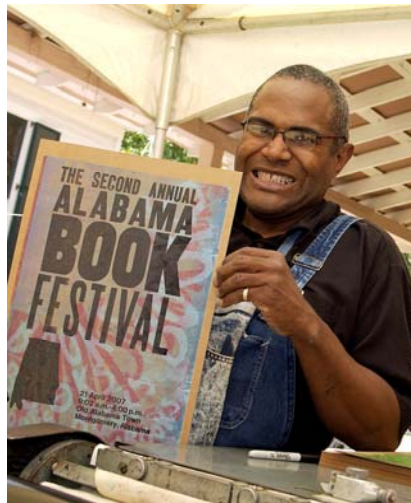
